**Each distributor may invite ophthalmologists, either current users of CSO products or prospective new clients, and will receive a contribution for each guest who effectively attends the congress**

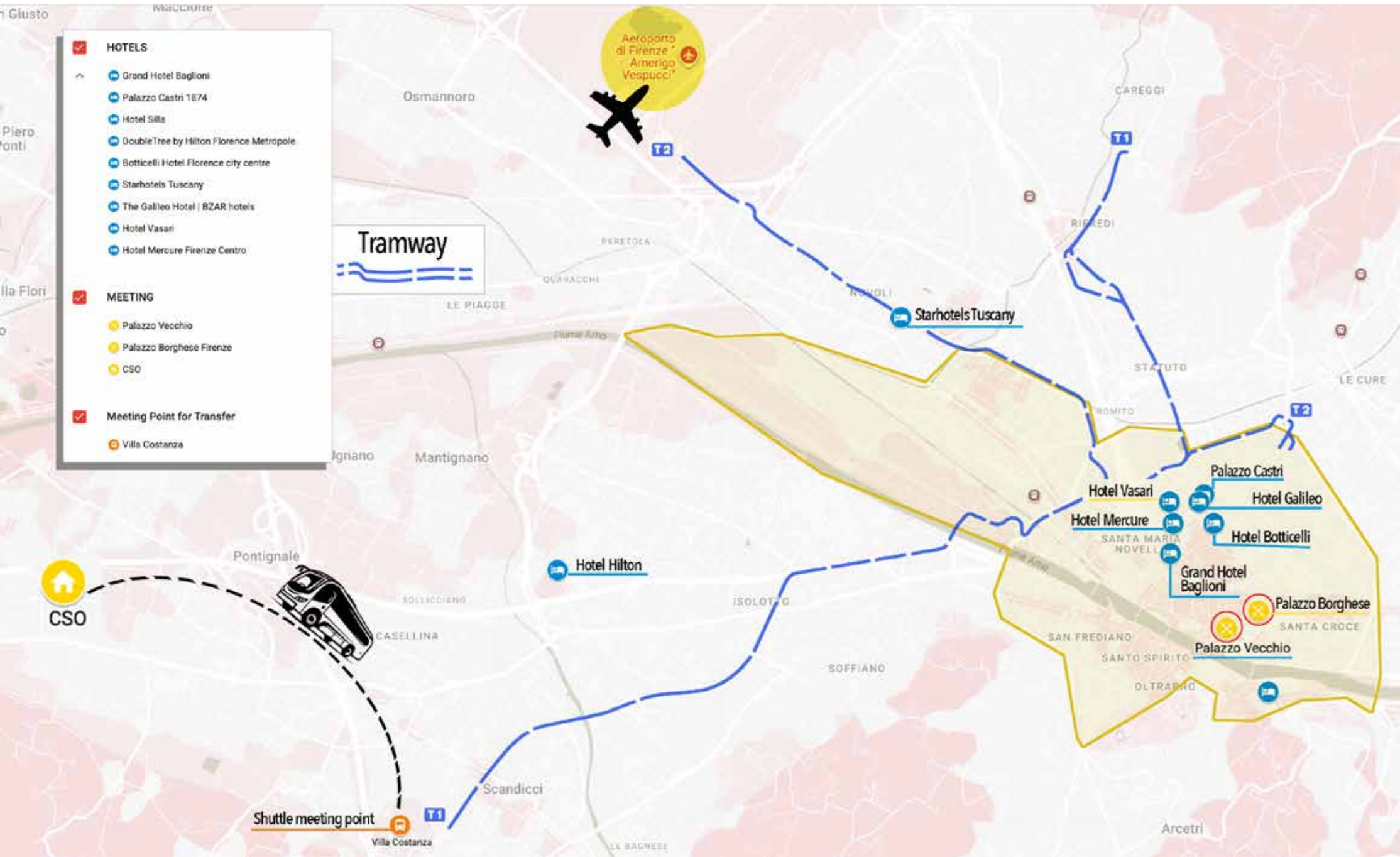
